- d. Disney Trip approval – Mr. Magee will discuss with Dr. Healy this week to find out.
 - i. November 3-6
 - 1. Leave late afternoon Friday, stop for dinner on way down (kids pay meal on way down and way home).
 - 2. Arrive Saturday morning then go to Magic Kingdom. Spend morning, do noon parade OR do the night parade.
 - 3. Then check into hotel and go to sleep.
 - 4. Stay at Country Inn and Suites or something like that – 4 or 5 to a room.
 - 5. Sunday breakfast, then go to Epcot. Spend day, middle of day and go to recording studio with Disney professional musicians. Then go back to park until it ends.
 - 6. Monday breakfast, then Hollywood Studios or Animal Kingdom, sometime during the day we take the color guard to do a workshop.
 - 7. \$975-\$990 per kids with 120 kids
 - a. 1 free adult with every 15 – 9 free adults. Need 4 staff, 1 or 2 uniforms, 1 nurse and the other adults.
