- I. Meeting called to order by Corie at 7:00 pm
- II. Announcements
  - a. None
- III. Secretary: Kim Bonifera
  - a. January meeting minutes have been posted to the website
- IV. Director: Don Magee
  - a. All District Band
    - i. 36 students made All District band
    - ii. 15 students are eligible for All State
    - iii. Everyone did a great job
    - iv. No other school had such a turnout
  - b. Marching Band
    - i. Virtual marching band started last Wednesday. Rehearsals will be outside (weather permitting) when we go 50/50
    - ii. The students are very excited to see one another again
    - iii. Mr. Magee has already acquired musician masks, bell covers, and flute sacks. The county paid for the masks
    - iv. A county meeting was held earlier this evening and a final decision will be made regarding whether or not the band will be able to play at the games.
      - 1. As it stands right now, band, cheer, and dance students are considered spectators
      - 2. Players and coaches are participants
      - 3. There is a 2:1 ratio of spectators to participants
      - 4. VBODA has not taken a stance because it is a county decision
  - c. Dates for the 2021-2022 school year have been set
    - i. August 2, 2021: Band Camp
    - ii. August 31, 2021: Tag Day
    - iii. September 24, 2021: Colgan Classic
  - d. The next School Board meeting is Wednesday, February 17, 2021
    - i. We as parents need to have our voices heard

    - i. Mr. Magee said that yes, Dr. Healey would support a stand still performance
    - ii. Corie will begin to think about logistics
  - d. If we are not going to have any sort of marching band, we have had some parents request a refund for their dues

    - i. We collected \$25 extra from seniors for the cost of banners
    - ii. Mr. Magee agreed that we should absolutely honor our seniors and create the banners
    - iii. Corie and Sandra will coordinate and plan to get uniforms ready for the pictures
  - f. Yearbook photo
    - i. If the band goes to a football game, Mr. Magee will take lots of pictures for the yearbook
    - ii. Parents can send in their own photos
